

XI JINPING IN EUROPE:

HOW AXIOM BUSTING IS THE KEY TO THE COMMON AIMS OF MANKIND

1. THE SPEECH OF XI JINPING IN PARIS

On March 27, 2014, the President of the Popular Republic of China, Xi Jinping, gave a poetic speech at the headquarters of UNESCO in Paris, demonstrating how the Chinese mind works for the purpose of improving the Western mind by causing an axiomatic change in the minds of his audience. The question is: "Can you succeed in doing that with poetry?"

Jinping's speech was prepared with the intention of causing a change in the minds of his audience with the hope of getting them to understand "harmony in diversity" and to "shape the common destiny of

mankind." He spoke in a poetic and creative manner, that is, "inclusively" from the Cultural Chinese matrix, extending olive branches over the waters of the stagnant French quicksand swamp. Jinping even went out of his way, in order to help the Western mind look inside of the Chinese mind to find, there, a common ground to build the future of world peace. But, is that enough to get the job done?

In doing, so, Jinping set the example of how to cause an axiomatic change among other civilizations outside of the Chinese world, by attempting to cause a shock through a cultural approach, in the same manner that Gottfried Leibniz had done four centuries ago, when he called for harmonizing the East and the West into a mutual outlook for human progress. Jinping spoke in the spirit of the motto written on the wall of Square of Tolerance in front of the UNESCO building in Paris, which states: "Since wars begin in the minds of men, it is in the minds of men that the defenses of peace must be erected." Most people attending the speech politely agreed with everything Jinping said, but how many understood the axiomatic significance of what he was trying to accomplish, because his axiom busting method was very different from the polemical method of axiom busting that LaRouche has been using. So, my question is: "Did Jinping's method have the same effect as LaRouche's?" Did it have the effect of causing a surge of energy-flux density inside of people's minds? No. Why not? Because it was done through diplomacy.

You might ask: "What's wrong with that poetic method?" There is nothing wrong with it, except it doesn't work for axiom busting. If your intention is to cause an axiomatic change in someone's mind, the method requires a kick in the ass. What must be said to the world at this time is: "I have not come here to please you; I have come here to shock you out of your complacency." This is the truth that you must discover in the organizing, if you wish to solve the problem of the present world strategic situation. You're not looking for people who will agree with you; you're looking for people who are willing to change their axioms by denouncing the enemy of mankind publically. The beauty of such an action, however, is that it can only be accomplished if you understand the inside of the human mind as the spectacle of a fight in the heavens between Prometheus and Zeus.

2. AXIOM BUSTING MUST HIT YOU LIKE THE THUNDERBOLT OF PROMETHEUS.

The intention of the Chinese President, Xi Jinping was very good, but his stealth method did not work, because the most urgent need in the world, today, is the truth; that is to say, the courageous act of confronting public opinion over the evil of the British Empire. Hopeful wishes will not do it. What is required is to abandon the stealth method of diplomacy and go with the brutal truth of open diplomacy that forces people to change. Why? Because your enemy is getting ready to wipe you out. What must be stated publicly by the Russian and Chinese leaders today is: "The British Empire is the enemy of mankind, and it should be destroyed." If world leaders are not willing to say that, then they must invite LaRouche to say it, in their name. The issue is either open diplomacy or you're dead. That's the only choice.

In other words, you cannot obtain peace by being peaceful with your enemy. As Lyn keeps demonstrating, you have to flank your enemy with superior weapons, and the superior weapon is the mind, the Promethean mind who wields power in proportion with reason. This means that the British Empire must be shut down with a lot of noise and clamor from the roof tops throughout Asia. How does that work? Let's take Helga Zepp-LaRouche's intervention in China recently and take note of her approach. Pay attention to her intention. The Beijing Review on March 23, 2014 reported Helga as saying:

"There is a general recognition in the world that the New Silk Road is only the beginning of a much larger integration of the world economy. We are very happy about this initiative because it will be the beginning of a completely new epoch of civilization... We need to change the paradigm quickly and abandon the idea of solving problems through war, and stop thinking in terms of geopolitics. We must focus on the common aims of mankind, or we all may not exist." (Helga Zepp-LaRouche, Silk Road to Prosperity, March 24, 2014.)

What is implied in Helga's call for a paradigm shift is precisely the axiomatic change in the minds of more than a billion people in China. That's what has to be done if you want to achieve the common aims of mankind. And it will not be done unless creativity is fostered across the board in China, through the appropriate axiom busting changes, especially those made through the new discoveries of principle, and most notably, the principle of an industrial processing of helium-3 from the Moon. That's where the axiom busting characteristic of the Chinese people lies today. As Lyn said:

"So the idea of merely saying, we're going to promise these good things, and be nice to each other is not going to solve anything. It's simply you're going to have a slow death, with mutual admiration, but, it's still slow death.

"What we need to do is fulfill mankind: Mankind has the power of creativity. The individual human being has a natural ability to create new states in the universe, where such states never existed before! And it's only through that power of creativity, of the human mind, that the human mind becomes human. Otherwise, you're just monkeys, and monkeys are not good at running political systems: You should see the rhesus monkeys in the zoo. They are not things you want around.

"So, therefore that is the issue. The issue is, are we going to be able, to sustain the inherent mission of the human species? And the human species is unique in the power to make discoveries, essentially in the form of chemistry: We go to increasingly higher energy-flux density, per capita and per unit of action. That is the only thing that enables the human species to exist. Therefore if you are going to do something for the world, you better get on your high horse, on thermonuclear fusion, and more advanced expressions of thermonuclear fusion which involve the lunar use of helium-3, to enrich this thing. We can do this on Earth! By bringing the helium-3 from the Moon, down to Earth, and incorporate it into a thermonuclear fusion program. That's the only way we're ever going to meet the challenge."
